TOILETRIES & BASIC SUPPLIES PROVIDED:

- USE PROVIDED RV specific toilet paper in the camper bathroom
- Regular toilet paper, tissues, paper towel or feminine products will plug the tank. Failure to comply will result in \$100 fee charged to your credit card to fix the sewer tank.
- A starter set of paper towel, toilet paper, tissues, dish soap, hand soap and trash bags ARE PROVIDED. Please do not remove extra/remaining supplies.

COOKING IN CAMPER:

- DO NOT USE THE GAS OVEN/STOVE TOP BURNERS IN THE CAMPER
- An electric Induction Cooktop has been provided for safe cooking
- Professional cookware/pans have been provided for the Induction Cooktop
- DO NOT USE cookware/pans on the campfire, it will ruin the cookware
- DO NOT USE any metal in cookware, it will ruin the cookware
- \$250 fee will be charged to your credit card for ruined cookware

SMALL APPLIANCES/ACCESSORIES IN CAMPER:

 Coffee pot, toaster, kitchen scissors, can opener, measuring cup, wooden spoons & spatulas (to use in induction cookware/pans) are provided

BEDDING/LINENS IN CAMPER:

- Bedding & bathroom towels are NOT PROVIDED
- Dish clothes, kitchen towels & pot holders ARE PROVIDED

PLEASE DO NOT DO IN CAMPER:

- NO PETS in the camper
- NO Smoking/vaping in the camper
- NO FISH CLEANING in the camper
- NO FISH SCRAPS disposed of anywhere in the campground

MUST HAVE ITEMS TO BRING WITH YOU TO THE CAMPER:

- Sleeping bags, blankets & pillows
- Hand & body towels & wash clothes
- Shampoo, conditioner, body soap, tooth paste, toothbrush, deodorant & cologne
- Clothes for both warm days and cool nights
- Coffee filters & coffee
- Ziplock bags of various sizes
- Plastic silverware, plates, cups & bowls
- Food & drinks, seasonings, condiments and treats
- Marshmallows!... don't forget the marshmallows!!

Please note: Firewood MUST BE BOUGHT LOCALLY (per DNR Regulations)
River Stop Gas Station (around the corner from the campground) does sell firewood

FUN STUFF TO BRING WITH YOU TO THE CAMPER:

- Boats, jet skis, ATVs, UTVs, Golf Carts, etc
- Bicycles, frisbees, football, badminton, gloves with a ball for catch, etc
- Board games, deck of cards, large legos, etc
